Class texts: My friend the Weather Monster, Grandpa and the Kingfisher

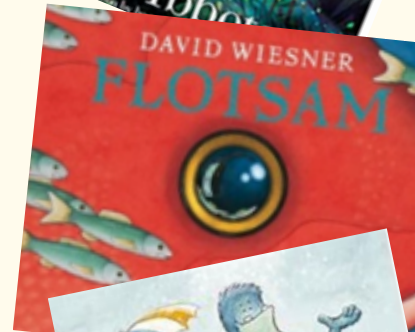
**Beacon:** The World Keeps Turning
